Overview

Selection Process

Entrants must be a non-profit group, community group or community sports facility operating in Manitoba. To be considered, please submit a complete application form (below), which will be reviewed by BridgmanCollaborative Architecture. The criteria for selection will be based on the stage, scope, community support, and timeliness of the entry. Projects intending to increase physical accessibility and/or child-friendly elements are strongly encouraged to apply. Selected groups will be contacted to schedule a consultation on Friday, Sept 30 or Saturday, Oct 1, 2011 at BridgmanCollaborative Architecture (678 Main Street).

Acceptance

Only accepted applications will be contacted regarding scheduling consultations.

Culture Days is a national celebration of art and culture aimed at raising the awareness and participation of all Canadians in the creative life of their communities. It's three days of free, hands-on, interactive activities that invite the public to participate "behind the scenes," to discover the world of artists and cultural producers at work in their community. The second annual Culture Days will take place Sept 30, Oct 1 & 2, 2011.
